

## **How to Write a Resolution:**

A resolution is basically a set of solutions to certain issues at hand. Resolutions are the final results of discussion, writing and negotiation. (They are written suggestions for addressing a specific problem or issue). Resolutions are broken down to two main components each starting with their own respective phrases:

- **Preambulatory Clauses:** Describes the current situation through facts and statistics .  
(Background)
  - *Reaffirming* that from 1918 to 1920, with the defeat of Germany in World War I, the nation was forced to accept a series of devastating reparations after signing the Treaty of Versailles which include heavy gun control and any sort of weaponry such air strike missiles, tanks, and etc,
- **Operative Clauses:** Describe the actions that the committee will take. (Solutions)
  - **Urges** all nations to support founding an organization that helps:
    - a. People who suffer from psychosocial traumas caused by small arms violence by:
      - i. Providing mental healthcare and psychiatric help,
    - b. People who are threatened because they want to get out of criminal organizations trading in small arms and light weapons, and develop a witness protection program for those by:
      - i. Providing protection for these people and surveillance around their activities with their consent;
