

## **How to Write a Speech:**

A stump speech is what you present to the other delegates to let them know your country's position. You talk about where your country stands on the issue and what your country wants to see happen in regards to the issue.

- **Introduction:**

- Loud clear voice for people to listen to you.
- You definitely have to use some type of hook in order to engage with the audience.
- Talk briefly about the issue and why your country would like to solve it.
- Try to make it enticing. Nothing is worse than sitting there listening to a boring speech!

- **Meat and Bones of the Speech:**

- You have to discuss your solution in enough detail for people to be excited about it but have enough vagueness for them to ask you questions about said solutions.
- Be confident in the solutions you are presenting and explain why your solution is going to be successful.

- **Conclusion:**

- Wrap up your speech.
- You can say basically anything you want to get the other delegations on your side.  
For example: *\*Thus, we are standing here before you today. We stand here in order to solve this issue by fighting for what we believe is right as one, united. We believe that uniting under one hand is the best way to extinguish this issue once and for all.\**
